Calling High School Artists (Juniors & Seniors Only):

Sorooptimist International of Davie is seeking ways to help bring an end to Human Trafficking and we hope you will help! As an artist, you are invited to enter SI Davie's Human Trafficking Poster Competition. High school students from western Broward County are invited to submit their original art for consideration to be published as a printed poster. All entries must be presented in portrait format only with a maximum size of 18 inches by 22 inches. All art mediums will be considered. Three winners will be announced on **Thursday, January 10, 2019** at Old Davie School Historical Museum and the winning artwork may be published as posters and displayed publicly throughout Broward County.

A group of jurists that includes professional artists and community leaders will choose the winners from among the entries submitted. SI Davie will present \$600 in prizes! The top three artists will be awarded ribbons, certificates and cash prizes of \$300 for First Place, \$200 for Second Place and \$100 for Third Place. Additionally, the Teacher of the winning student will receive a \$50 cash award as our thanks.

To be eligible for this competition you must:

- Read through everything carefully and be sure you understand the application.
- Complete the Application Form following the instructions provided.
- **Deadline for entries is 2 PM on Friday, December 7, 2018.**

Rules, Regulations and Contest Information

ARTISTS, PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION

1. Due to the mature subject matter, entrants must be a **junior or senior** enrolled in a Broward County High School, public or private.
2. **Only individual artists** may enter; group entries will not be considered.
3. **Submit** the following components: design based on the approved theme. (*Read below for details on the "Theme."*) Final art work must be submitted on paper or canvas with maximum dimensions of 18" X 22" and must be created utilizing portrait layout only.
4. **Design Elements List** (see Application Form) should include the medium used. State whether it is a photograph, painting or drawing. If it is a collage or other type of mixed media, please include a list of materials used.
5. **Tag Your Work!** It is a good idea to include an ID tag on the back of your entry that provides title, artist's full name and phone number in the event your Application is separated from your art entry. You may also attach your Application to the back of your artwork.
6. **Signed Permission Form** (see Application Form) Students age 17 and under need a parent or guardian's consent to participate in this contest. PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY.
7. **Submit your completed Application Form** with your art entry to Soroptimist International of Davie **no later than 2 PM on Friday, December 7, 2018**. 8. **Selection of Finalists:** A panel of jurists that includes artists and community leaders will select the finalists from the art work submitted and three winning artists will be announced during SI Davie's Human Trafficking Awareness event at Old Davie School on **January 10, 2019**. The finalists' art entries will be exhibited at public and private venues throughout the Town of Davie, Broward County, State of Florida and local media, following the announcement of winners. If you are selected as one of the finalists, you will be notified and your presence will be required for the presentation of awards.
9. **Theme.** All entries must address the theme of **"Human Trafficking."** You may interpret the theme however you choose, but it must be clear in your final art work. Freedom of expression is granted to all artists. However, controversial, offensive or politically charged material will not be considered. Please keep this in mind when creating your design. The use of brand names and commercial endorsement is prohibited. Profanity, nudity, political statements, and offensive material will not be accepted. The decisions of the judges is final.
10. **Judging:** The criteria for finalist selection includes: concept, creativity, design, originality, use of materials, interpretation and execution of the theme **"Human Trafficking,"** following directions and completing the application.
11. **Decision of the jurists is final.** We are seeking art that is universally appealing and inspiring to viewers of all ages that conveys the message that we must all work to Stop Human Trafficking.
12. **Prizes:** All finalists receive a certificate of appreciation. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded as follows: First Place \$300; Second Place \$200; Third Place \$100. The winning artwork may be published as posters for distribution throughout Broward County to aid in increasing the public's awareness of **"Human Trafficking"** and the Soroptimist mission to stop it.
13. **The Fine Print:** Entries will be on display at Old Davie School for public view on January 10, 2019. All photos and artwork may be used by Soroptimist International of Davie in any and all media for the purpose of promoting the mission of ending Human Trafficking. Application submissions will not be returned unless requested in writing. Artwork will be available for return after January 10, 2019 reception. SI Davie is not responsible for entries that are damaged or lost in transit and reserves the right to judge those entries as received.
