POSTER CONTEST

ART CRITERIA

Work must be original, not a copy of another artist's work. Art must capture an image or images of Human Trafficking. Mediums may include oil, watercolor, pastel and acrylic painting, mixed media, photography and collage. Art must be presented in portrait layout suitable for reproduction of a poster. Maximum size of original art is 18x22 inches. **Landscape format will not be accepted.** Work must be clean and ready for framing. Artwork must include a tag with the title of the work, artist's name, phone number and signed release, on the back of the artwork.

ARTIST'S AGREEMENT

Open to Broward County high school Public and Private juniors and seniors. Submission of art for consideration shall constitute an agreement to comply with all the rules set forth. The winning artwork will be printed as a poster and displayed in public venues including local shopping malls, offices and public buildings. Several posters from past years are on exhibit in the Capitol Building in Tallahassee, Florida. Soroptimist International of Davie reserves the right to use selected art on its website and in media to promote our Stop Human Trafficking awareness project. Original artwork will be exhibited to the public. Cash prizes will be paid by cash to the winning artist or his/her parent or guardian following the awards presentation at the SI Davie Human Trafficking Event on January 10, 2019. If the winner is not present to claim his/her prize at the event, the prize (via check) will be mailed no later than January 30, 2019. SI Davie reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering with the entry process or the operation of the art competition. Failure to comply with the rules of the contest may result in a contestant's disqualification and/or forfeiture of any prize or prizes. SI Davie reserves the right to disqualify that entrant from entering and/or winning future competitions, and to prosecute and/or seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law. Mailed entries must be in appropriate and adequate packaging to prevent damage. If an entry is received in damaged condition, the contestant will be notified, and unless replaced by the submission due date, it will be judged as received.
